## The Ambulance Chaser

A lawyer cannot ethically or legally contact someone in an accident for the purpose of being hired unless the lawyer is invited to do so by the injured person or a person authorized to do so. Unfortunately, unsolicited contacts by lawyers are all too common. These so-called "Ambulance Chasers" often have a network of "Runners" who prey on people involved in all types of accidents, especially accidents that receive lots of publicity, e.g., motor vehicle collisions, airplane crashes, fires and other type of accidents involving multiple injuries. Ambulance chasing is especially common in ethnic communities among low income victims of accidents. They often do not have the sophistication to know how to retain a top notch lawyer, nor do their friends and family have such knowledge.

Most lawyers who participate in ambulance chasing are not capable of obtaining a fair and reasonable recovery on behalf of their ill-gotten client and thus end up re-victimizing the client.

The Ambulance Chaser will often pay a kick-back of part of his fee to a runner who brings the case to the lawyer. This "under the table" payment is also unethical and illegal.

A person who is seriously injured needs to be protected against these uninvited attempts to "sign up" with the Ambulance Chaser. This is most important because the uninvited contact is often made soon after the accident at a time when the victim and the family are most vulnerable and unable to make an informed decision regarding obtaining legal representation.

Of course, it is important to contact a lawyer as soon as possible, when you are seriously injured.
